RESIDENTIAL VISIT 2019

You will be aware of the fact that Y6 children spend one week of their final year at a Kingswood Outdoor Education Centre. We regard it as an integral part of the curriculum and strongly recommend that children take part. This year we have once again decided to visit Dearne Valley, which is in Doncaster, South Yorkshire. We have been allocated a week in October of this year, **the exact date being 14th until 18th October 2019.**

The cost of board, lodging, transport will be **£262**. Unfortunately, there are no free places granted to families on Universal Credit.

To help with the cost of the visit we spread the payments over three separate dates (please see details below). Once a payment has been sent in, your child will be issued with a printed receipt for your records.

To confirm our booking an initial deposit of **£80** per child will be required by **Friday 1st March 2019**, cheques can be made payable to Clifton with Rawcliffe. Please contact Gill Johnson, School Business Manager, should individual circumstances make this difficult. The following payment amounts and dates will be:

Final Payment: 04/07/19 £91

Please note that the deposit is non refundable and subsequent payments may not be refunded depending on the date of cancellation.

The children benefit greatly from their residential visit, not only educationally but also in their own personal growth. A kit list for your information is attached which will give you an idea of what your child will need for the trip.

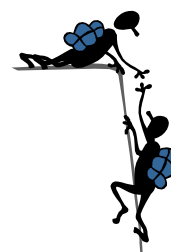

CLOTHES FOR ACTIVITIES

- Several pairs warm thick socks
- 3/4 long sleeved tops / sweatshirts
- 2/3 warm t-shirts
- 2/3 pairs warm trousers (warm jogging bottoms are better than denims which take longer to dry if wet)
- Anorak or similar waterproof
- 1 pair of waterproof trousers
- Warm hat and scarf
- 2/3 pairs gloves
- Wellington boots / Walking boots

Water Activities (Kayaking & Raft Building)

The following items need to be in addition to other clothing as will only be worn for the 2 water activities.

- 1 pair old trainers/plimsolls - they will get wet/muddy
- Old t-shirts/shorts/leggings/joggers to be worn in the water

OTHER ESSENTIALS

- Pyjamas/night-dress
- Several changes of underwear
- At least one change of clothes for evening activities & disco
- 1 pair of trainers for indoor work / evening activities
- 2 Towels (1 bath towel and 1 for swimming)
- Washbag with soap, flannel, toothbrush and paste, brush/comb, shampoo
- Handkerchiefs/tissues
- Lipsil or similar cream
- A suitcase/bag to carry everything in
- Water Bottle (essential)

OTHER USEFUL ITEMS

- Writing materials including a stamped and addressed postcard to be written and sent home on arrival.
- Book to read / small quiet game (not electronic)
- £10 is ample spending money (please send in coins rather than notes)
- Named disposable camera (if children wish to bring an inexpensive digital camera they must take full responsibility for any loss or damage that may be caused)
- Several empty carrier bags to pack muddy items in for the return journey

NOT ALLOWED :- Chewing gum, Knives, Mobile phones, I pods (or any other handheld electronic device)
Aerosol cans (e.g. deodorant, body spray, hair spray) as can set off smoke alarms.

IMPORTANT NOTES: - Every item of clothing **MUST** be labeled with the child's name. All valuables e.g. jewelry, watches etc. are brought at the owners risk. It is a good idea to attach a list of the child's belongings to the lid of the case to enable a check to be carried out before departure.

ANY MEDICINES SHOULD BE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH NAME AND DOSAGE AND HANDED TO THE DESIGNATED TEACHER ON THE MORNING OF DEPARTURE.
