Dear Parent/Guardian,

On Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May, Year 5 will be visiting The Yorkshire Arboretum and taking part in pond dipping, mini beast hunting and team building activities.

The children will be leaving school after morning registration and will return by the end of the school day. As we will be doing outdoor activities children **do not have to wear school uniform** and we recommend old clothes as they may get muddy. Depending on the weather children may also need to bring waterproof clothes and a warm coat, or sun cream and a sun hat (fingers crossed!). Trainers should be worn and each child needs to bring a pair of wellies or walking boots in a named bag.

Pupils will require a pack up for the day, and can we kindly remind you not to give glass bottles or fizzy drinks. If your child is entitled to free schools meals a packed lunch will be provided by school.

The cost of the trip will be £10.75 per child, which covers the cost of travel, entry and all activities. All monies will be paid for from the Enrichment contributions collected at the beginning of the school year.
