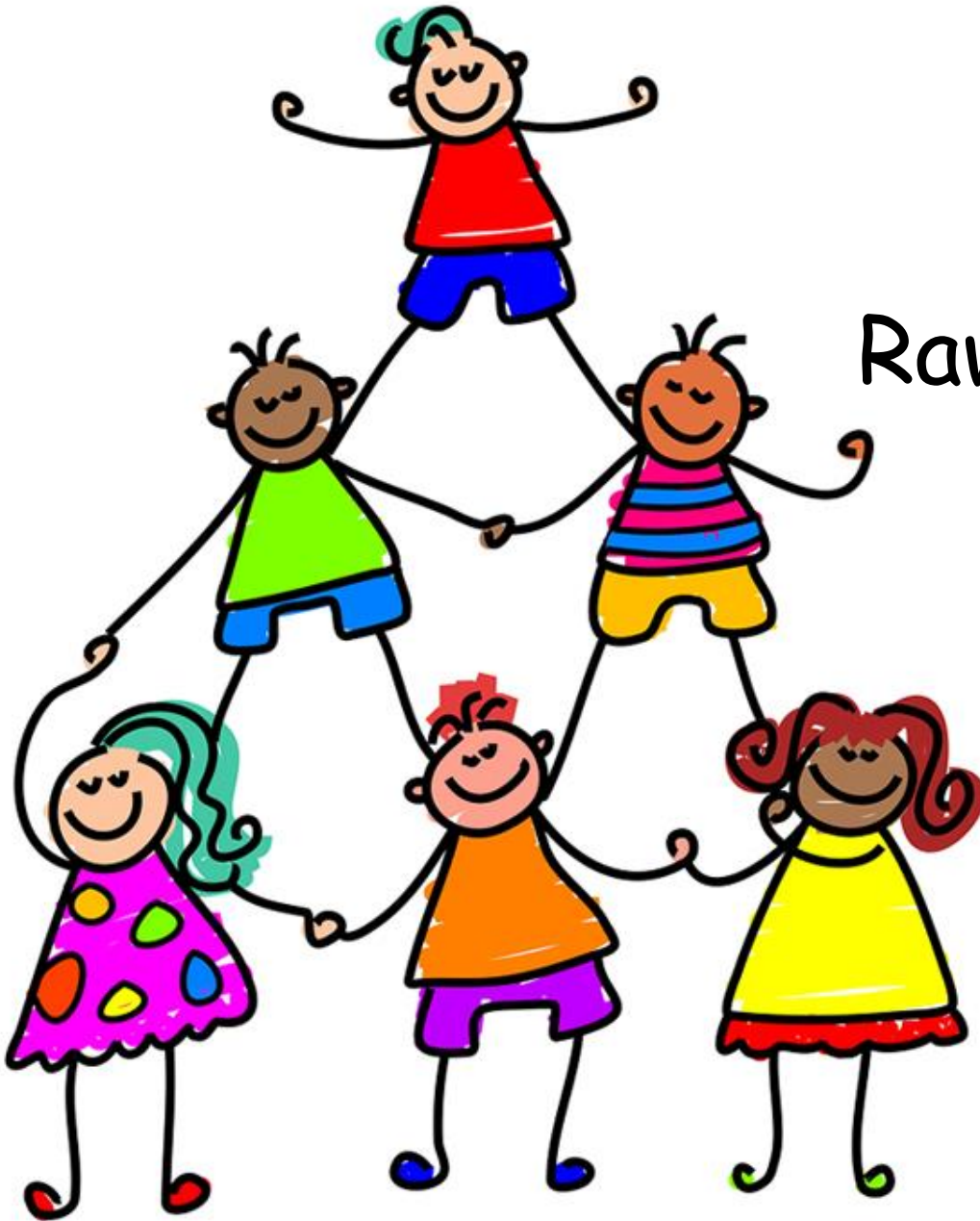

Full time/Part time Options

All FS2 (Reception) children can start full time at Clifton with Rawcliffe in September 2018

We generally find that nearly all parents opt for their children to start school full time in September.

Parents may, however, wish their child to start part time in September.

Therefore the options for your child to start FS2 are;

- Full time from September 2018
- Part time from September until the October Half Term becoming full time on 5th November 2018
- Part time from September until the end of the Autumn Term becoming full time on 8th January 2019
- Part time will mean children attending each day 8.45am - 12.50pm



Transition Sessions

- 3 taster sessions we will be holding in July
- This will be an opportunity for you and your child to meet their teacher; to meet other children within their learning group and to become familiar with the FS2 environment
- During the time your child is in these sessions would also like to offer you the opportunity to attend a series of parent workshops to help with the transition into school
- The sessions are entirely voluntary but if you choose not to attend we would ask you to leave your child in FS2 and return to collect them at the end of the session

Uniform requirements

Uniform

Girls

Red or Navy Sweatshirt or Cardigan
White, Red or Navy Poloshirt or White Blouse
Grey or Black Skirt, Trousers/shorts or Pinafore
Plain Black, Grey or White socks or tights
Dark coloured shoes preferably black

During warmer weather red or navy gingham dresses and plain open toed sandals that fasten around the ankle may be worn (with socks).

Boys

Red or Navy Sweatshirt
White, Red or Navy Poloshirt or White Shirt
Grey or Black Trousers/shorts
Plain Black, Grey or White socks
Dark coloured shoes preferably black



What does my child need?

PE Kit in a drawstring PE bag - Plain White crewneck t-shirt, plain black football or cycle shorts & trainers for outdoor work. Please can we ask, if possible, that trainers have a Velcro fastener to help children whilst getting dressed / undressed.

Forest School Kit in a Black Forest School drawstring Bag (available for purchase via school) - Waterproof Jacket, Waterproof trousers and Wellington Boots.

PE & Forest School kits need to be brought to school every Monday and taken home to wash every Friday.

Jewellery

Children are only permitted to wear up to 1 stud in each ear. If you are thinking of having your child's ears pierced please ensure this is done at the beginning of the 6 week summer holidays to allow enough time for the ears to heal as children must be able to remove their own earring's for any PE based activity Any child unable to remove their own earrings will not be permitted to participate in the lesson.

It is essential that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name
